On March 26, 2014, I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to information. Upon arrival I met with Mark Mitchell. Mitchell invited me into his home and I immediately noticed that the floor was shaking and the pictures on the wall were shaking. As I looked around the house I noticed that the shaking of the floor and personal items became stronger in certain parts of the house. I asked Mitchell what was causing the floor and walls to shake. He stated that Haren Construction is about 75 yards away from his home doing some construction for the City of LaGrange and they are driving large metal beams into the foundation. Mitchell stated that not only is the vibration and noise a nuisance, but he is concerned for the integrity of his foundation. Mitchell stated that this has been going on now for a week and a half. Mitchell stated he needed documentation in case something happened to his foundation or the structure of his home. I gave Mitchell a case card and advised him how to obtain a copy of the report.

On March 31, 2014, at 1740 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival I met with Mark Mitchell. Mitchell invited me into his home and I immediately noticed that the floor was shaking and the pictures on the wall were shaking. I was familiar with the Haren construction company working approximately 70 to 75 yards away from his home. As I was inside his home the shaking of the house seemed worse today than it was a couple of days ago. I observed change jars that were on dressers, lying on the floor with all the money spilled onto the floor. This time the windows in the house were flexing back and forth vigorously. According to Mitchell, the construction company was normally stopping around 1700 hours. However, the last couple of days he stated that it seems that they go later and later. When I left the residence at 1830 hours, they were still working and the shaking of the house was still ongoing. Mitchell stated that it is constant from the time they get started in the morning till they stop in the evening. He stated that he has pictures fall from the wall, things get knocked over that were on dressers and countertops. Just like before, the shaking got stronger as you walked throughout the house. I gave Mitchell this case number so he could pick up a copy of the report for his records.

On Thursday, 04/03/14, at approximately 21:21 hours I was dispatched by Troup E-911 to [REDACTED] reference a meet complainant about damage done to her house by city construction. I re ponded code 1 and upon arrival spoke with the complainant, Diana Mitchell, who stated that when she returned home today she observed a large metal picture/frame had fallen from her wall which was approximately 20 feet high and landed on BOSE speakers causing them to no longer function. The falling picture/frame was extremely large and also caused damage to the wall and a Vase. Mitchell stated the frame fell due to constant work by the City of Lagrange employees immediately next to her residence where she stated a sewage plant was being constructed. She elaborated that everyday during this construction there is constant rattling and shaking of her residence which causes all the pictures hanging in her house to move or fall

Mitchell was able to show me multiple examples in different rooms, which I photographed, and later attached to this report. I also took photographs of the fallen frame in the living room along with the damage caused. Mitchell stated she has called LaGrange Police Department on two prior occasions and spoke with several officers regarding the issue to include Capt. Pheil. Mitchell stated she wants to work with the city to correct this issue but has gotten no success as of yet. I informed her that due to her complaint about the city I would inform my direct Sgt. who I knew would inform the proper channels and hopefully create further contact or even resolution. Mitchell stated she would appreciate that.

After departing [REDACTED] I spoke with Sgt. Nelson regarding the incident.

On 09/16/2014 at approximately 1309 hours I, Deputy Blackburn, was dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a miscellaneous incident. Upon arrival I spoke to Mark Mitchell and he reports that the Haren Construction Company is causing damage to his residence. Mitchell reports that Haren is removing large steel beams from the ground and is causing his residence to shake. While speaking to Mitchell, inside of his residence, the entire house began to shake. The vibrations were very extreme. I walked with Mitchell over to the fence of Haren Construction. The sound from the machine removing the beams made normal conversation impossible to hear. The machine and Mitchell's residence are extremely close to each other. I gave Mitchell a case card with a case number. Report for documentation.

On 10/27/14 at about 0200 hours, I responded in a code one manner to [REDACTED] in reference to a vehicle with a man sleeping inside.

Upon arrival I found that there was a tractor trailer with a load that was parked at the front of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Immediately I could see that the vehicle was loaded down and delivering commercial equipment.

I approached the tractor and spoke with the driver. I asked if he was supposed to meet workers at this gate entrance some time soon and he advised that he was supposed to drop this load around 0700 hours. He advised that he was told that it was a commercial plant and did not know that the entrance to the construction site was in a neighborhood. He advised that once he entered the neighborhood he could not turn around.

I found that the construction entrance was gated and had a chain preventing the truck from going in. I attempted to see if the tractor could back his way out from the front of [REDACTED] but the only way to exit the neighborhood was to enter the construction site and make a u-turn and pull back onto the street that he came in on.

The resident of [REDACTED] met with me and advised that he has encountered multiple commercial vehicles coming into this entrance at all times of the night. When they pull up, they would let there air brakes off and some would keep their diesel engines idling. On this occasion, there was no other choice but to have the rig stay until the gates are open and have him turn around inside the commercial area.

The trucking company was named as the Larry Fike Trucking Company out of Pennsylvania. The DOT number for the carrier was 2474826. The driver was Larry Fike, phone number of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] I ran his PA DL and it was found to be valid, DL# [REDACTED] PA tag of [REDACTED] on the trailer.

On July 17, 2014, I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to damage to the property. Upon arrival I met with Mark Mitchell. Being familiar with the recent calls to this location regarding the Haren Construction company doing construction on the property next to Mitchell's, he immediately escorted me inside to show me the damage that has been caused to his home as a result of said construction. On several occasions have I have been in the home when construction was going on, to feel his home shaking, the walls shaking, the glass in the windows and doors vibrating so bad there was a fear of them breaking, to see things knocked off walls and off dressers. Mitchell walked me downstairs to show me that the ceramic tile on his bottom floor has cracked from about mid room to the wall, cracked in the bathroom and just outside the doorway. I observed that the foundation in his garage had shifted about a ½ inch from the wall, causing the strairs to shift and start cracking. The back glass door that leads to his back porch was shattered. I issued Mitchell a case card and advised him how to obtain a copy of the report.
